



SERVICE PROJECT REFLECTION

Due Dates: **8th Grade Week of March 8** 6th & 7th Grade Week of April 19

Reflection is a critical part of a service-learning course. Students who take the time to reflect on service-learning experiences will get more from those experiences. This is why reflections are a required part of Confirmation preparation. Reflection helps students thoughtfully process their work of service. It helps them critically assess and understand what they are seeing and doing. It allows students to be the hands and feet of Jesus.

INSTRUCTIONS

Choose 1 of your service projects; on a separate piece of paper answer the following questions as you reflect on how you were the “hands and feet of Jesus”:

1. Describe your service opportunity, how did you help others, how did it help you?
2. Describe a person you encountered during your time of service who made a strong impression on you, positive or negative.
3. How does this organization or group you helped address the needs of others?
4. What were your reasons for choosing this particular type of service?
5. What was your attitude toward service prior to beginning?
6. During service, what were some of your thoughts and feelings about what you were doing?
7. After completing the service project, what were some of your thoughts and feelings about service?
8. Did this experience change your attitude toward service? Explain.
9. How does the role of service relate to your faith in the life of a follower of Jesus?

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
