

Congratulation on having been asked to serve as a sponsor for Confirmation! This is a wonderful privilege and not one to be taken lightly. We offer the following information to you for your consideration as you become more involved in this new role.

The Role of the Sponsor



The sponsor is to take care that the confirmed person behaves as a true witness of Christ and faithfully fulfills the obligations inherent in this Sacrament.” (Canon 892)

A sponsor for a Confirmation candidate is meant to provide spiritual help to the candidate (Catechism 1311) He or she should be willing to serve as a strong and lasting Christian influence on the candidate. The sponsor enters into a spiritual relationship with the candidate and acts as a sort of spiritual parent and mentor. Therefore, it is both a great blessing and a responsibility to commit to the role as a sponsor.

You are called-

- To witness, by your life, how a Catholic Christian lives in today’s world. Your concern for life, justice, and peace, for the poor and oppressed, and your involvement in doing good for others are the strength of your life as a witness.
- To guide in times of doubt, indecision, confusion, to be a good listener, ready to give advice as a Christian adult when asked.
- To be a friend, one who is “there” when needed, one who can be trusted.
- To take an interest in the Confirmation program your young friend is involved in.
- To get to know the candidate in a new way, as a sincerely interested young Catholic, freely coming to Confirmation and ready to take on a mature responsibility as a Catholic in his or her sphere of influence.
- To share your faith story with your young friend.
- To be ready to publicly vouch for the Candidate’s readiness to take on the role of one sent forth to bring the Good News of Jesus Christ to others by the quality of his or her Catholic life.
- Above all, it is expected that, as a person of regular prayer, one celebrates the Sunday Mass with a parish church and leads a sacramental life, you will begin to pray each day for your young friend.

- **Attend Confirmation Mass on Saturday TBD 2022. Refer to your student for time of mass.**

Canonical Requirements for Sponsors (Canon 874)

The Universal Church specifies that a sponsor must:

- Must be 16 years old.
- Be a Catholic who has received the Sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist.
- Lead an active life of faith (e.g. weekly attendance at Sunday Mass, regular reception of the sacraments of the Eucharist and Reconciliation, etc.)
- Not be the father or mother of the one to be Confirmed. (Parents can stand as proxy for a sponsor of record)
- Godparents are the desired choice for a sponsor.

Parish Requirements for Sponsors

1. Sponsor must provide a Sponsor Certificate of Eligibility/Sponsor Referral initiated from their home parish, sealed/signed by the priest, stating that he or she is a practicing Catholic in good standing. **Due November 7, 2021.**

NOTE: Sponsors who attended St. Joan of Arc PSR program and were confirmed at St. Joan of Arc need **not** submit a form.

2. Candidate may choose only **ONE** sponsor.

We recommend that one sponsor per candidate as the relationship demands such a significant time commitment and personal attention from the sponsor that it would be difficult to meaningfully develop the relationship envisioned by the Church if a sponsor had more than one candidate. However, if there are extenuating circumstances please contact the middle school coordinator.
